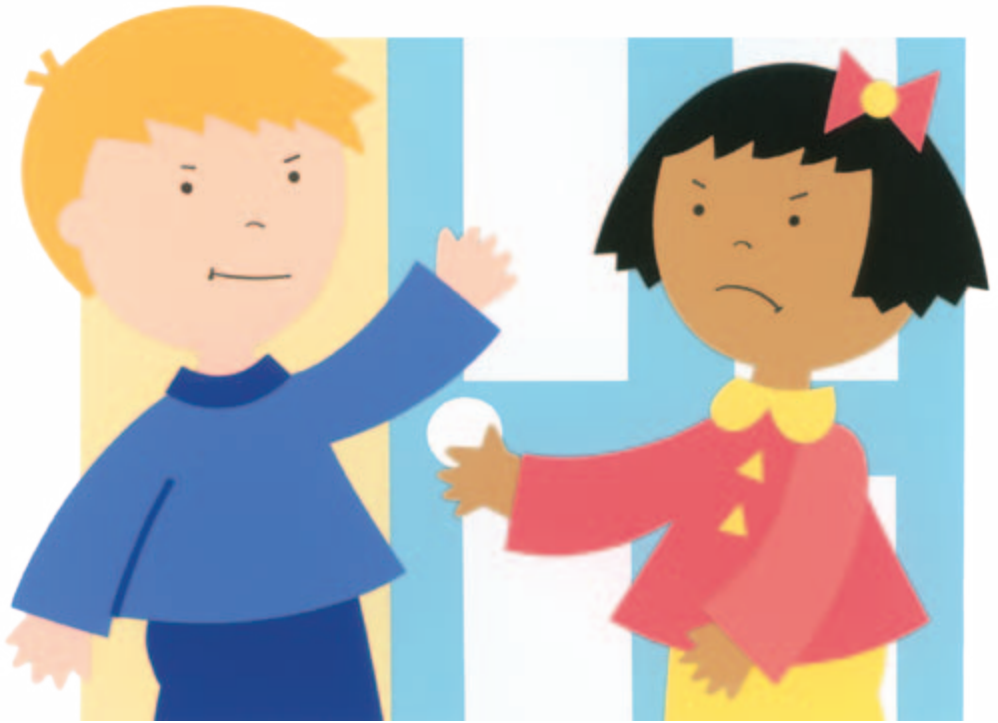

“I can!” Kevin said.

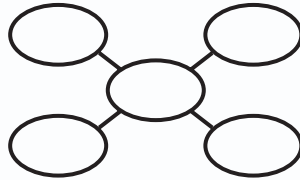
